

## Patient's Privacy Notice: Badger Maternity Notes

### Title of service/ process/ system

Badger Pregnancy Notes is used by South Warwickshire NHS Foundation Trust (SWFT) and is subject to the overarching GDPR privacy notice for the organisation. This is available on the Trust website at <https://www.swft.nhs.uk/privacy-policy>

Badger notes is online portal and app that allows pregnant women access to their maternity records via their PC, tablet device or mobile phone. The information is generated in real-time from South Warwickshire Foundation Trust maternity services and is input by those involved in an individual's care, whether it is a midwife or other health professional. When a woman transfers her care to SWFT maternity from another Trust who also use the Badger notes platform, then this information is viewable by SWFT maternity services and vice versa.

Badger notes allows pregnant women real time access to their maternity records

### What type of information we have

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Name
- Address
- NHS number
- Phone number
- Cultural and Social identity
- Medication
- Summary of your health
- Summary of your pregnancy and birth

### How we get the information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- To assist in providing appropriate maternity care

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing your personal information are:

Your consent. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting [contact details]

*Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we rely on an additional legal basis for processing your health/ ethnicity information. This is:*

- (a) We have your explicit consent
- (b) We need it for health or social care
- (c) We need it for public health

### What we do with the information

We use the information that you have given us in order to provide safe, effective maternity care.

We may share this information with other maternity Trusts who either we refer an individual to; or who an individual may choose to refer themselves to. We may access information from other Trusts. We may also share this information with social care services.

### How we store your information

Your information is securely stored within the Badger Net Platform.  
We keep your personal data in line with the Records Management Code of Practice.

### Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

**Your right of access** - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

**Your right to rectification** - You have the right to ask us to rectify information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

**Your right to erasure** - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

**Your right to restriction of processing** - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your information in certain circumstances.

**Your right to object to processing** - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

**Your right to data portability** - You have the right to ask that we transfer the information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
