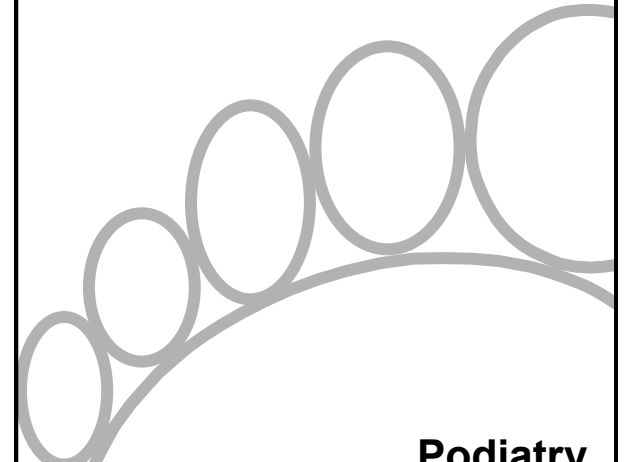
**PALS**

## **What can I expect from the appointment?**

We aim to give an in depth neurology assessment and try to address any foot complaints that affect your mobility by stabilising the lower limb, promote foot health education and health wellbeing.

## **How long will it take?**

Please allow up to an hour for the appointment. Appointment times do vary and may be shorter than an hour.

## **What will I need to bring/wear?**

- Please bring an up to date list of your medication
- Comfortable, loose fitting clothes as we may require to see your knees.
- Current footwear

(pairs that you regularly wear). **Including a lace up shoe with a tongue**

- Mobility aids e.g. Splints, ankle foot orthoses, insoles, walking aids.

## **Where will I be seen?**

Neurology appointments are made from specialist sites that provide treatment for patients for the whole of the county of Warwickshire. Your initial appointment maybe at Leamington Hospital.
